Dear IDEA Lab Kids Family,

Like you, we are actively monitoring the coronavirus (COVID-19) situation and are taking extra precaution. That's why we're doing all we can to make sure our campuses are up to CDC recommendations on cleaning and disinfection.

We encourage you to continue to follow existing guidelines to protect your own health. The Centers for Disease Control recommends:

- Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds; use alcohol-based sanitizer if no water is available
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- Avoid close contact (within 6 feet) with those who are sick
- Stay home if sick
- Cover cough or sneeze with tissue, throw tissue in trash, wash hands
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched object and surfaces

At this time we are opting to run classes and camps as normal, adding the recommended additional cleaning measures. Please be advised any noticeably ill staff or children will be sent home immediately. This includes runny nose, sneezing, coughing, fever, and even allergies; as we just cannot afford to take any chances at this time.

It's important we come together and support one another during this time. The health and safety of our children continues to be our chief priority. We will continue to follow all guidance and take the appropriate measures accordingly, as well as stay in consistent communication with you all.
